

**MINUTES  
HARWICH REPUBLICAN TOWN COMMITTEE  
FEBRUARY 16, 2017**

- 1) **Call To Order** – Vice Chairman Eric Carroll, who filling in for Chairman Peter Hughes, called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2) **Minutes** – The minutes were previously e-mailed and then distributed by Secretary Pat Switchenko. Deborah Waugh made a motion to approve the minutes of January 19, 2017, which was seconded by Gayle Carroll. There was no discussion and the minutes were approved unanimously.
