

**MINUTES

OCTOBER 18, 2018**

- 1) **Call to Order** – Vice-Chairman Eric Carroll, filling in for Chairman Peter Hughes, called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2) **Minutes** – Minutes had previously been issued to the committee for the meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Deborah Waugh made a motion to accept the minutes which was seconded by Gayle Carroll. There was no discussion and they were approved by all

- 6) **Political Updates:**

The group shared some thoughts about politics and personalities. Eric reminded the committee about Flags for Vets around Veterans Day, where 67,000 flags have been placed in the past. Gayle will add the date of the event to Facebook.
